

#### **GREETINGS! NGĀ MIHI!**

This weekend is a busy weekend for the Cathedral. On 25 November, the Ordination Eucharist will be held in the Cathedral Nave. Candidates will be ordained to the Diaconate and to the Priesthood. We invite you to pray for these individuals and their journey as deacons and priests.

Sunday is Christ the King Sunday and it marks the end of the Christian Liturgical year. We will have an adult baptism during the 10am Choral Eucharist and Confirmations with Bishop Ross at 5pm in the Bishop Selwyn Chapel.

Sunday the 3rd December marks the beginning of Advent - the new Christian year. Along with our usual 8am and 10am services 'The Advent Procession: From Darkness to Light' will take place in the Nave at 8:30pm. You will find details of this service in the newsletter.

The months of October - December are now defined by the countdown to Christmas, and the season



of Advent is often overlooked. Advent marks the start of the church year and is characterised by expectant waiting for the nativity of Jesus at Christmas. In the sacred calendar, Advent is quite separate from Christmas: one follows the other. Indeed Christmas doesn't start until 24 December - not an idea that would be welcomed by the retail industry! There is a sense that our secular Christmas activities have submerged Advent, meaning the rhythm of expectant waiting is lost beneath an extended period of spending and excess.

Next week in the newsletter I will include a 'Countdown to Christmas to do list' to help each of us prepare ourselves during the Advent season for the coming of Christ.

One way of understanding fasting is as intentionally increasing our awareness of our heart's desire. Advent can easily be subsumed by the end-of-year business and busy-ness of Christmas.

This brief series offers an opportunity to spend a little time before Advent begins re-orienting ourselves to the gift and mystery of this season. A journey to prepare for the journey, if you like. An exploration over three sessions engaging with images and symbols, concepts and words. The overarching theme is to prepare ourselves for the invitation to deeper faith which we will each encounter during the season of Advent. Each session will conclude with a brief service of Night Prayer.



The use of candles is a traditional and very beautiful practice in Advent carol services. Please join us for this service.


### CHARITY YOGA CLASS
