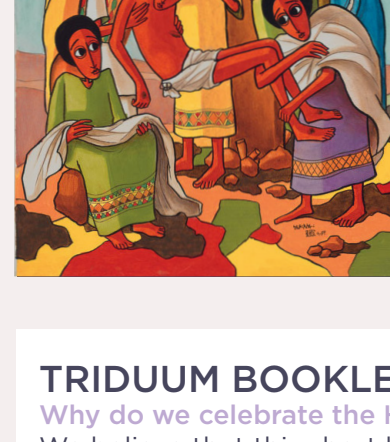
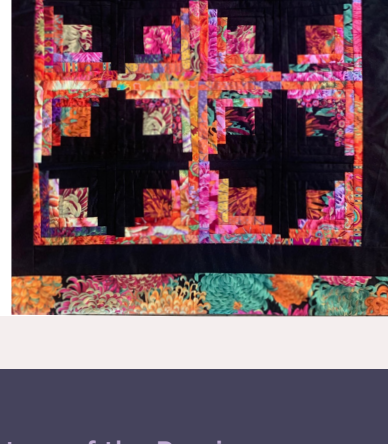
KNEE RUG FUNDRAISER

There are seven pictures displayed in the Cathedral through Lent, Holy Week and Easter, each presented with resources for meditation/reflection.

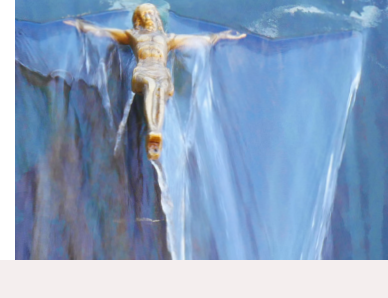

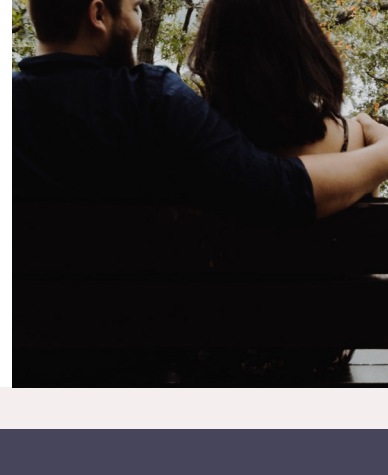
SUPPORT THE AUCKLAND CITY MISSION
