This week the Anglican Archbishop in Jerusalem has joined the Patriarchs and heads of churches

in Jerusalem in calling for a global day of prayer and fasting for peace in the midst of the current conflict and humanitarian crisis in that region.

In his letter, Archbishop Hosam says: 'Once again we find ourselves living through hard times in the Land of the Holy One, where we are surrounded by war, violence, hatred, and destruction. Many in our region now live with great fear and uncertainty. Nevertheless, from Jerusalem, the City of the Resurrection, I send you all hope for the assurance of a better life: one with a brighter future, more blessed circumstances, and freedom from bloodshed, injustice, and death.'


