10am Sunday 27 March

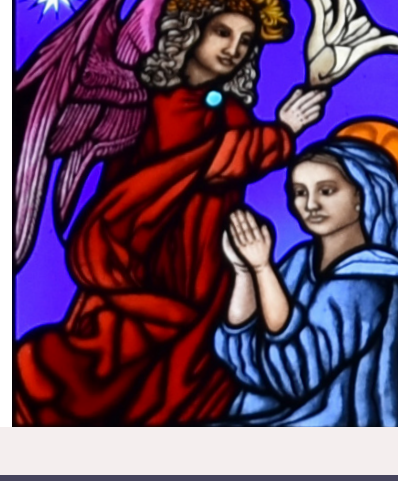
Fourth Sunday in Lent/Te Rātapu Tuawhā o Rēneti

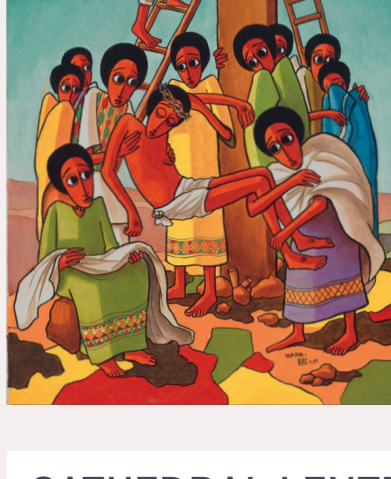

### LENTEN STUDIES 2022

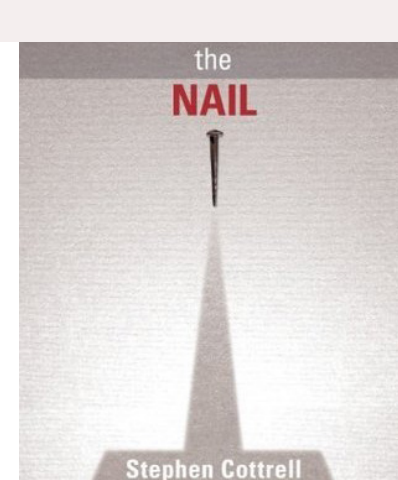
7:30pm Mondays 7, 14, 21, 28 March & 4 April

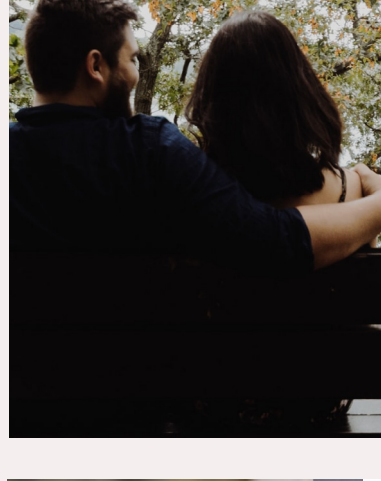
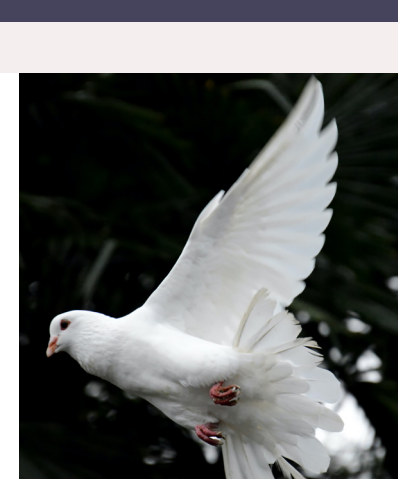
This Sunday, representatives from the various faith communities of Aotearoa-New Zealand will be leading the prayers and readings online for peace in Ukraine, Europe, and the World.

### SUPPORT THE AUCKLAND CITY MISSION

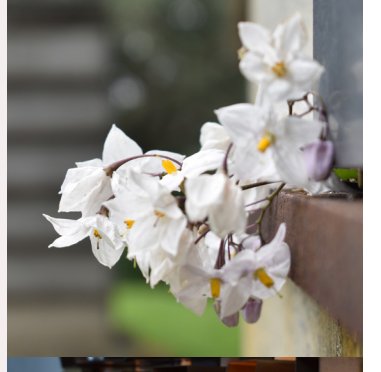
Sam and Irene's story

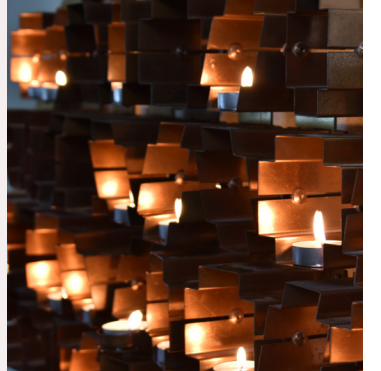
