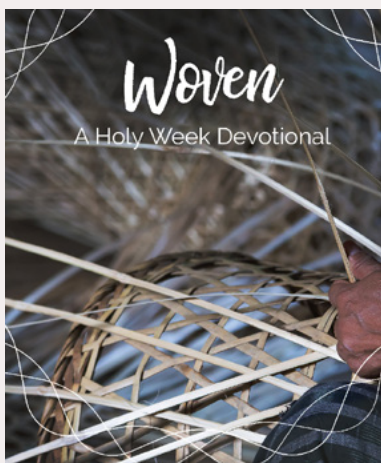
RNZ EASTER DAY SERVICE

which is broadcast at 7am and 10pm on RNZ National, and 9am on RNZ Concert. The combined audiences for the broadcast and online versions is well over 100,000. The service will also be available online on the RNZ website.

A CORONATION CELEBRATION

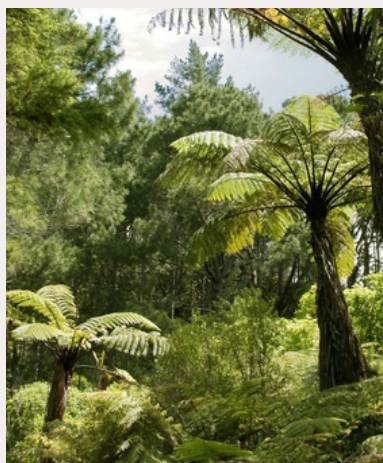

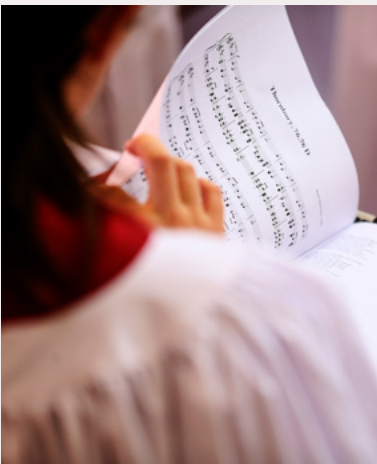


JOIN THE CATHEDRAL CHOIR

DONATE TO AUCKLAND CITY MISSION

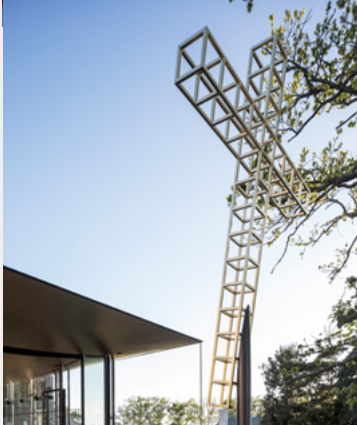
Please consider donating food to help our most vulnerable neighbours
