



Holy Trinity Cathedral will be featured in the RNZ Easter Day Service which is broadcast at 7am and 10pm on RNZ National, and 9am on RNZ Concert. The combined audiences for the broadcast and online versions is well over 100,000. The service will also be available online on the RNZ website.

Producing the service this way is much less time-consuming than a live broadcast, and enables the full range of Easter services at the Cathedral to go ahead without interruption.

## JOIN THE WELCOMING TEAM


We are looking for people with a passion for art, architecture, and the history and traditions of the Anglican Church in Aotearoa New Zealand.
