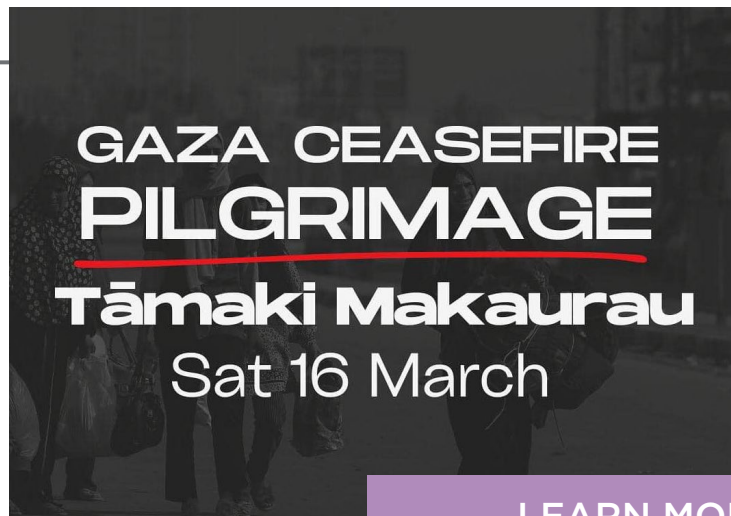

GREETINGS! NGĀ MIHI!

I am sure that many of us had an awful feeling in our hearts when innocent Israeli civilians and young concert goers were cruelly attacked by Hamas on 7 October. Many hostages were taken into captivity and more than 100 are still missing. That initial horror was only augmented by the disproportionate and cruel military response on the Gaza Strip which is still ongoing, and has caused more than 30,000 deaths (and counting). Among the victims are the small, fragile Christian communities that exist in Gaza since the earliest Christian times.

This Lent, a global movement, in over 100 cities in more than a dozen countries, is walking in prayerful solidarity with the people of Gaza. If you are Auckland-based, do join us in solidarity with those suffering, to pray 14 stations of the cross, while making a symbolic pilgrimage. **Join the pilgrimage at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre at 6am on Saturday 16 March.** You are welcome to walk all or part of the 41km route - the length of the Gaza Strip, which more than 1.5 million Gazans had to walk in search of safety, which does not exist for them.

You can also help by donating to the Anglican Missions' campaign supporting Al Ahli Hospital in Gaza which continues to operate and serve its community.

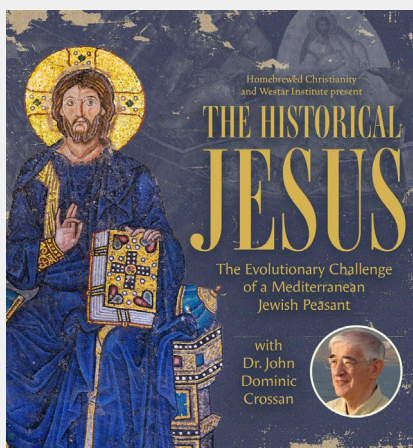
Join us in the Friends' Room for our annual Lenten Studies Series. This year's study will follow a resource by Waiapu Diocesan Ministry Educator, the Reverend Debra Broome, entitled *God's Call: who is God calling us to be?*

The five study sessions, held at **10am and repeated at 7pm each week**, will engage with some aspect of a call from God, whether to the Church as a whole and to all Christians, or to an individual or a particular role or life. As we travel along together we will meet a collection of people who have responded to God's call in the past. There will be passages from the Bible to look at and questions to think about, and to answer in groups. The evening will conclude with Night Prayer.

All are welcome as we journey through the Season of Lent together.

GUEST PREACHER

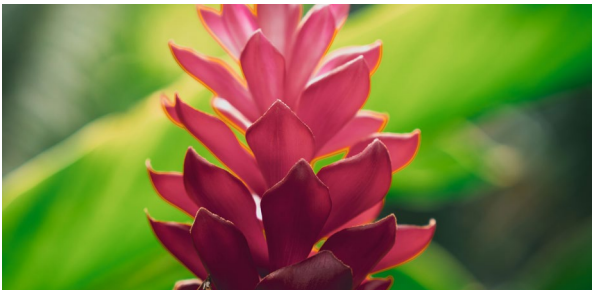

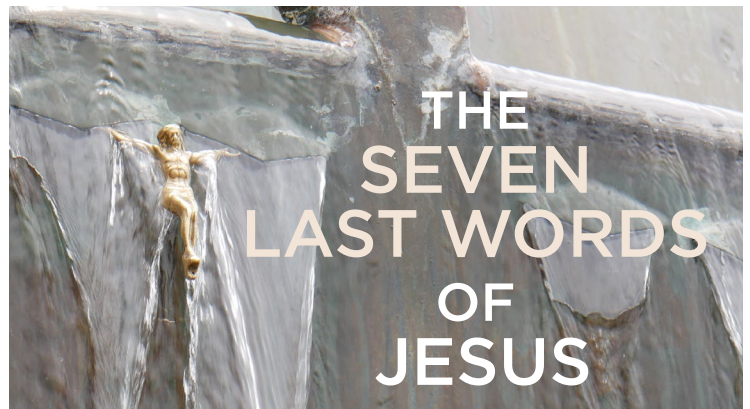


PARNELL FOOD TRUCK

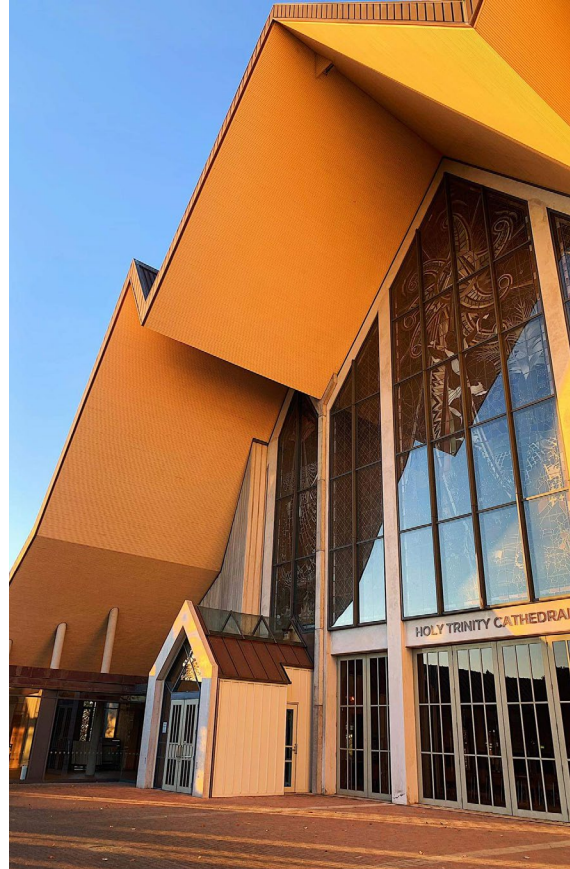
