

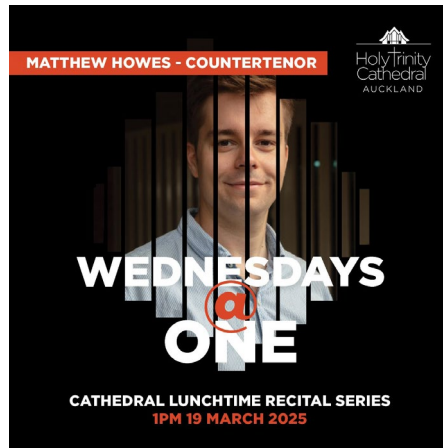
COMMONWEALTH DAY SERVICE

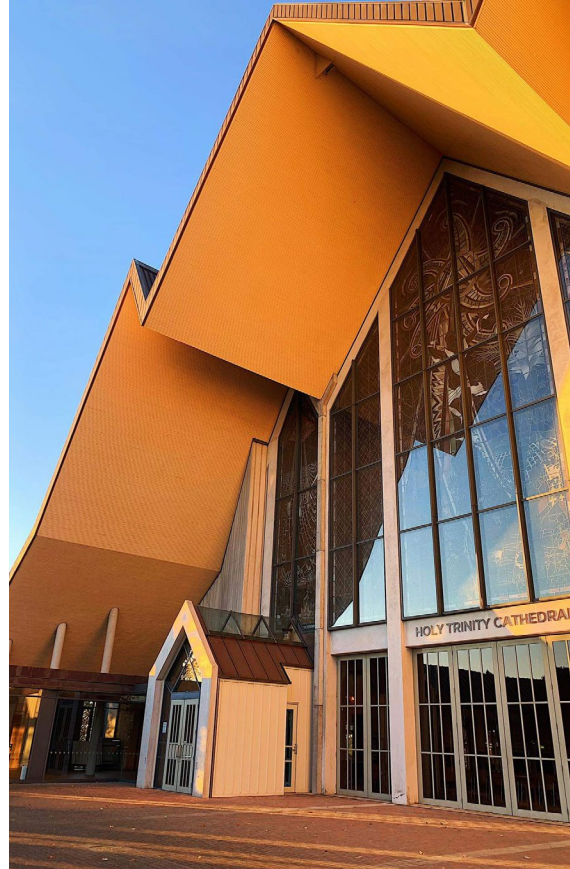
