This richly deserved honour recognises Ann's extraordinary contribution to the arts in Aotearoa New Zealand and the influence her pioneering work has had on generations of glass artists.

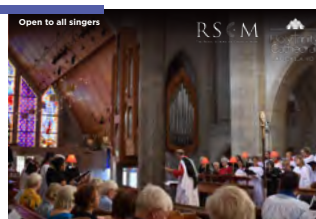

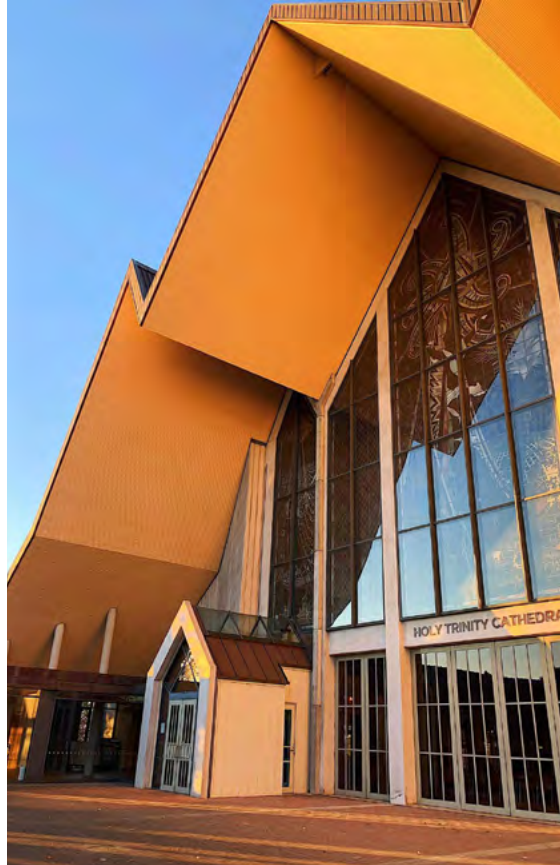
