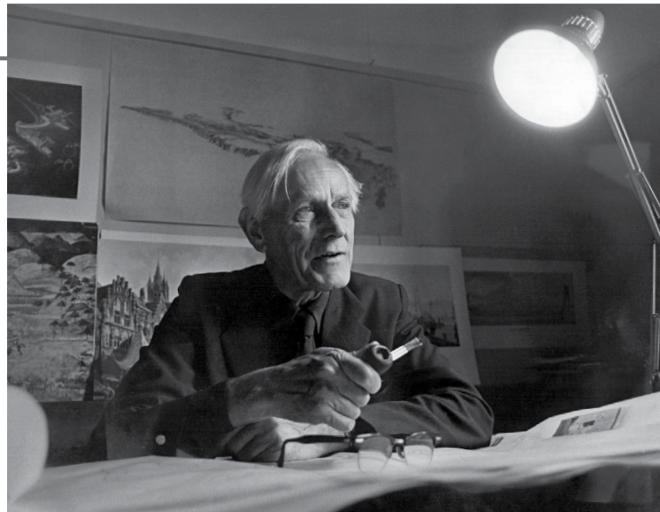

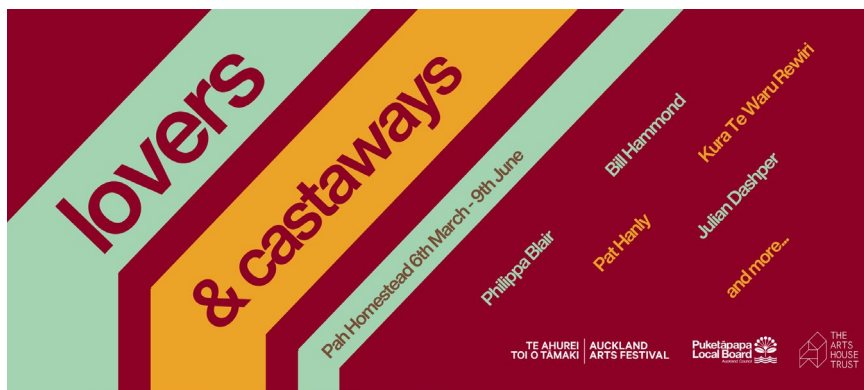
### MIDDAY EUCHARISTS

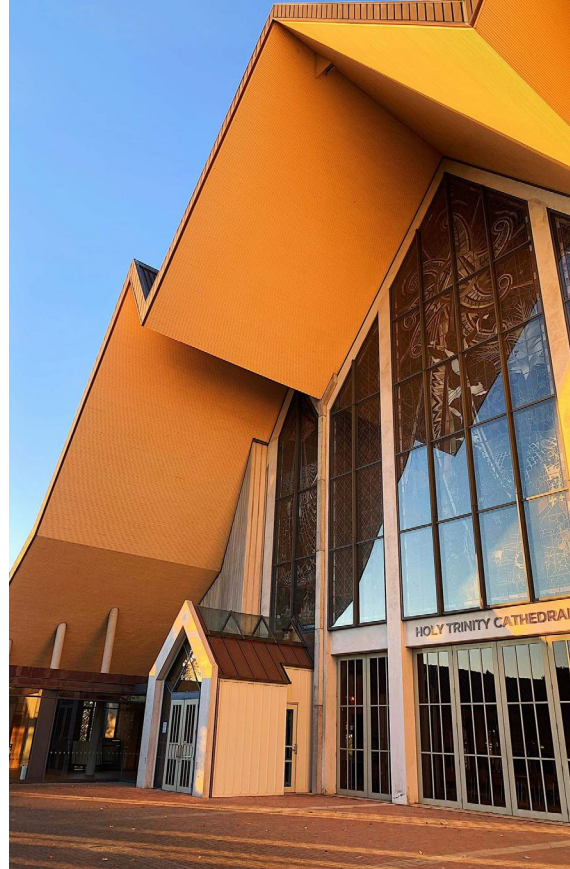
