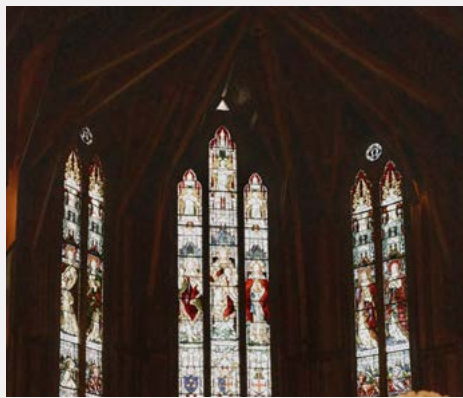

Andrew Carter's setting brings this ancient text to life with imagination and charm, including additional verses for children's voices—featuring creatures great and small, from hedgehogs to dragonflies, alongside the familiar wonders of creation.

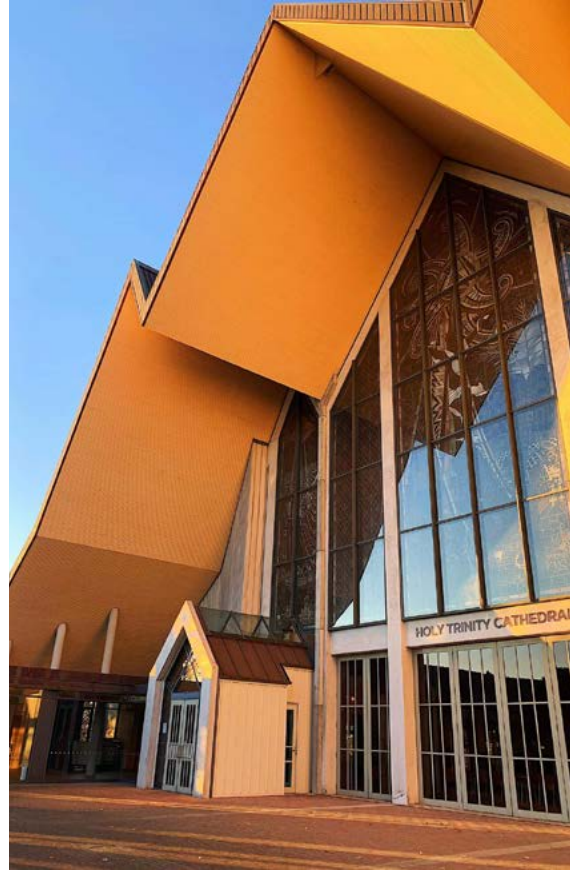
