INTRODUCTION

CHRISTIAN MARRIAGE

In the Anglican Church, marriage is intended by God to be a sacred and creative relationship grounded in love, and mutual support. God's blessing enables two people to journey together in love for the rest of their lives, sharing in the spirit of Jesus Christ.

At Holy Trinity Cathedral, we value the opportunity to support couples who wish to give thanks for their love and seek God's blessing for their future. Your wedding is a public declaration of this commitment, made before God and witnessed by family and friends.

One or both partners must be baptised in the Christian tradition.

Your service will be conducted by Cathedral clergy, with the possibility of other ministers participating by arrangement and at the discretion of the Cathedral clergy.

We continue to hold couples married here in our prayers and remain available for ongoing support.

MARRIAGE PREPARATION

Marriage preparation is required and included in your wedding fee. Our one-day IMAGO course (9am–5pm) offers practical tools to strengthen your relationship, combining group discussion with private reflection.

We want to help you build a strong foundation for your marriage and believe that a marriage preparation course is an important part of this process.

You will need to register for this course when you meet with one of our clergy.

If you are unable to attend, please speak with Cathedral clergy about alternative options. Any external course costs are your responsibility.



SERVICE AND MUSIC

PLANNING YOUR SERVICE

Your wedding will follow the Anglican tradition. You will choose from three authorised service forms in A New Zealand Prayer Book/He Karakia Mihinare o Aotearoa, and further personalise your service with hymns, readings, and prayers.

At least one reading must be from the Bible. Additional readings may be included and read by family or friends. Our clergy will guide you through this process.

If you wish to include Holy Communion, this should be discussed early in your planning. We aim to create a service that is both faithful and welcoming to all.

MUSIC

Organ music:

Each of our venues is equipped with an organ. The Cathedral Organist, Dr Philip Smith, is available to assist with music selection. You are encouraged to meet with him to explore music that speaks to you as a couple.

Recorded music:

Recorded music (CD/MP3) is supported in most spaces. External musicians are welcome; however, rehearsal time is limited. The organist is not present at rehearsals but is available separately if required.

WEDDING REFRESHMENTS

The Bishop Monteith Visitors' Centre is available for post-ceremony refreshments:

100 seated / 250 standing
\$600 (incl. GST) plus \$500 refundable bond
Non-commercial kitchen

Catering must be arranged separately. Refreshments are not permitted within the main Cathedral worship spaces.

YOUR WEDDINGS DAY

We ask that the groom and his party arrive at your chosen venue 30 minutes before the service is due to begin.

The bride must arrive at the agreed service time as we may have other weddings following yours. Please arrange your pre-service preparations accordingly.





PRACTICAL DETAILS

FLOWERS & DECORATIONS

Our venues are places of Christian worship and liturgical furnishings cannot be moved or removed.

Flowers and decorations are your responsibility
Please coordinate access with the Cathedral office
Access to your chosen space is one hour prior.

Guidelines:

No flowers are permitted on any of our altars
Decorations must use ribbons only with no adhesives, nails, staples, or wire
Flowers and decorations must be removed at the conclusion of the service.

Confetti & Petals:

No confetti or rice is permitted anywhere on Cathedral grounds
Flower petals may be used outside our buildings only with the permission of the Dean.

Candles:

The Cathedral's existing candles are lit by the vergers
One unity or memorial candle may be used (by arrangement)
No additional open flames are permitted (though electric alternatives are allowed)

PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEOGRAPHY

One official photographer/videographer is permitted. They must liaise with our clergy before the service.

The photographer/videographer must not obstruct or interfere with the service at any time.

If you would rather your friends and family did not take photos during the service, please print this instruction in your order of service.

WEDDING REHEARSAL

A Cathedral vergers will assist at your rehearsal and wedding.

The wedding rehearsal is held during the week prior
The rehearsal duration is 1 hour
Please attend your rehearsal with wedding party, readers, and ushers



BOOKING AND FEES

MAKING A BOOKING

To secure your date:

- Meet with Cathedral clergy
- Submit booking form
- Pay:

\$500 non-refundable deposit

\$500 bond (if booking the Bishop Monteith Visitors' Centre)

No dates will be held without both the form and deposit.

Important:

- Separate weddings are scheduled at least 2.5 hours apart
- If your wedding is the second of the day, access is one hour prior
- We do not conduct weddings on Sundays, Holy Week, or late December – early January

THE MARRIAGE LICENCE

Apply approximately 90 days prior to your wedding date through the Department of Internal Affairs.

- Your licence is valid for 3 months
- Processing time is generally ~3 days

The completed licence must be emailed to the Cathedral office two weeks prior to your wedding. **We cannot conduct a legal marriage without a licence.**

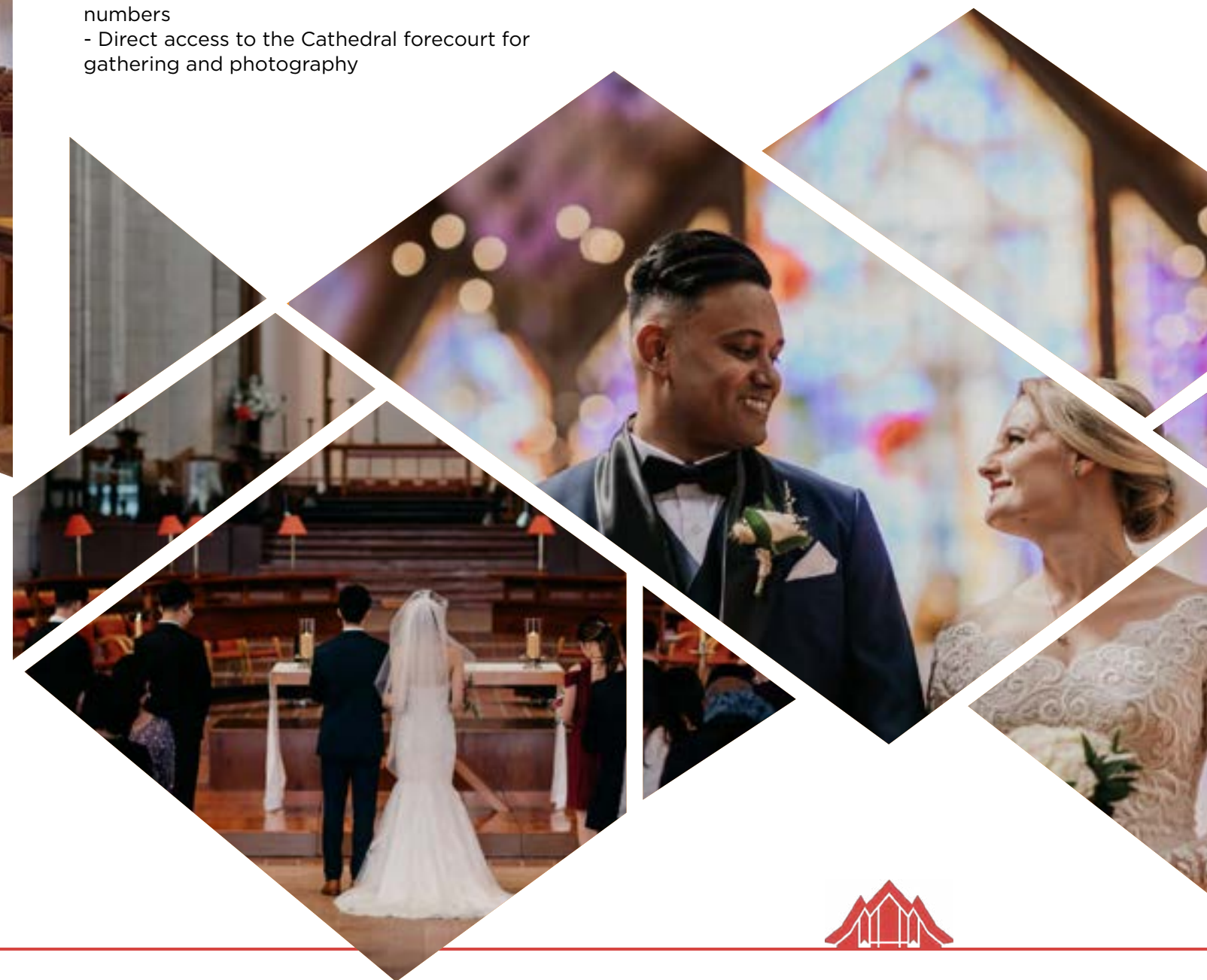
