GREETINGS • NGĀ MIHI NUI

As winter approaches, many families across Aotearoa are facing increasing pressure, with schools reporting growing numbers of children arriving hungry and without the basic essentials needed to learn well. The KidsCan “20 for 20” campaign is an urgent appeal asking those who are able to donate \$20 in support of the 20% of Kiwi children living in households where food regularly runs out.

For more than twenty years, KidsCan has provided practical support including food, jackets, shoes, and health products to children in schools and early childhood centres throughout New Zealand. The organisation now supports more than 1,400 schools and centres nationwide, helping remove barriers to learning and participation.

At the heart of the campaign is a simple reminder of our shared responsibility to care for one another, particularly the most vulnerable among us. Even a modest contribution can make a meaningful difference to a child facing hardship this winter. I ask you to consider if you might give your support to this
